General Supplies: Each academic class has an assigned color for notebooks, binders, and/or folders to help students stay organized throughout their school day. You will find the colors listed next to each class in the table below. While it is not required, we do recommend that students follow this system as closely as inventory in stores will allow. Please anticipate keeping some supplies at home to be replenished as needed. Please LABEL EVERYTHING with a Sharpie!

- 1-2 pencil cases (soft-sided, not a box)
- Earbuds or headphones (each student is required to have their own pair)
- 1 package 8 fine tip washable markers
- 1 package colored pencils
- 2 large glue sticks
- 1 bottle of white-out
- Scissors (small)
- 1 box dark blue or black pens
- 1 box red pens
- 3 boxes pencils
- 2 block erasers
- 4 pack assorted color highlighters
- 4 packs of loose-leaf paper (college-ruled)
- Suggested:
 - Handheld pencil sharpener
 - Personal stapler
 - Personal hole punch (One that connects to a binder is recommended.)
 - o 1 scotch tape dispenser
- Optional
 - Stylus or Apple Pencil

Health Safety Supplies for Classrooms:

- 4 large boxes of tissues
- 1 large container of disinfectant cleaning wipes
- 1 antibacterial hand sanitizer gel (16 oz or larger) *above 60% ethanol or 70% isopropanol alcohol
- 2 large roll of paper towels (1 Roll for STEM Class)
- Personal safety eye goggles for STEM laboratories

Personal materials should be organized as follows:

- Pencil Case 1: 3-5 dark pens, 2 red pen, 3 pencils, highlighters (1 blue, 1 pink, 1 yellow, 1 green), 1 eraser, pencil sharpener, earbuds,
- **Pencil Case 2**: small scissors, 1 glue stick, 1 white out, colored pencils, markers (removed from packaging can use an elastic to contain), small stapler, scotch tape

Math (Blue)	TX30-IIS scientific calculator - no graphing calculators, 2" binder, 5 dividers for binder - no pockets, 1 subject spiral notebook with perforated paper, 1 pack of graphing paper (Can be a notebook with perforated edge), 12 inch clear ruler with in & cm, box of sharpened pencils (can be mechanical), pencil sharpener, 2 block erasers, colored pens for grading
STEM (Purple)	1" binder, 1 subject spiral notebook, 5 dividers for binder - no pockets in dividers, safety goggles (saved through all 3 years), colored pencils, scissors, glue stick, tape dispenser,, colored pens for grading, blue or black erasable pens
Social Studies (Red)	1-Subject Spiral Notebook, Pocket Folder, 1 Package of 3x5 index cards
Theology (White)	1-Subject Spiral Notebook for Theology only, 1 Pocket Folder, 1 composition book/journal.
	(Recommended: CATHOLIC NAB Bible for home use)
Spanish (Green)	One wide-ruled composition notebook with a cardboard cover One 1.5 inch 3-ring binder One package of 5 tab binder dividers One pack of wide-ruled filler paper 2 packs of 3x5 index cards 1 Spanish/English Dictionary (paperback) 1 pack of index card rings (can be found at the dollar tree) 4 elmer's glue sticks
